








The North American Riders Group announced yesterday evening their top 25 horse shows throughout North America and place Thunderbird 2nd overall.



Applications will be accepted until April 15, 2014 for events taking place before December 31 of the current year.

Applications from HCBC members clubs will be accepted throughout the year. Once approved HCBC will notify the club contact of the amount of the grant to be given.



Managing manure in a responsible way can be a challenge for some horse farm owners. Rising costs of storing and hauling manure away add to the overall daily upkeep. The high density and mixed farming of the Fraser Valley has its own set of unique challenges. Some acreages just don't have the capacity for proper composting or manure storage. But there could be an affordable sensible solution for the overburdened horse owner trying to deal with the manure mountains. So what other options are there? Working together, horse farms in the Fraser Valley have an opportunity to remove and recycle their horse manure.

Manure Used Bedding Recycling Co-op MUB is an affordable, responsible solution that offers mass composting through group participation without tipping fees or bin rental costs. When used properly, manure is a valuable nutrient resource that can be recycled or used in the production of pasture management or other crops. A co-operative model is a great way to increase value and productivity for the horse industry and offer affordable alternatives of manure management. Interested in learning more?





### Did you know?

For most horses, a body condition score of 4 to 6 (out of 9) is recommended. The new Code establishes a common understanding of when to take corrective action for horses who are too thin or too fat.
