Equine Canada/NCCP Competition Coach Specialist - Western Prerequisites



The Competition Coach Specialist is a coach who is actively working with the competitive rider. The coach will continue to stress basic riding, horsemanship and safety skills, but is expected to be capable of advancing students to Silver and Gold competitions. The coach should be able to evaluate a horse and its suitability for a student, supervise stable operations and routines, and have experience in training horses for competition.
