NOTE: Instructors must achieve the standard in each task.

Outcome #1 - Planning a Lesson/Schooling Session

Plan must include:

- a) Logistics
- b) Appropriate activities
- c) Emergency Action Plan (EAP) (One only for home venue)

TASKS - Plan two lesson/schooling sessions. The instructor candidate must submit lesson plans for assigned lessons:

- 1. On the ground
- 2. In the carriage

Outcome #2 - Provide Support to Drivers/Horses in Training

- a) Ensure that the lesson/schooling environment is safe
- b) Implement an appropriately structured and organized lesson
- c) Make interventions that promote learning

TASKS - Teach three lessons.

The instructor candidate must:

- 1. Teach a Lesson on the Ground
- 2. Teach a Lesson with Horse and Carriage
- 3. Teach a student how to lunge/double lunge a horse

Outcome #3 - Analyze performance

- a) Detect errors
- b) Correct errors

TASK- Detect and correct errors in drivers and horses. The instructor candidate must detect and correct errors in drivers and horses
