Frequently Asked Questions

Is every road in BC under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure?

No, a number of municipal roads are maintained and managed by municipal government and not subject to this initiative.

Do I need to be part of a group to request enhanced signage?

No, any rider can contact the Operations Manager of their nearest MoTI district office in writing and request enhanced signage.

How long will it take to have enhanced signage installed?

That will depend on the schedule of the district office involved; the Operations Manager you work with will be able to give you an idea of the timeline.

Can I have a Share the Road tab *and* a distance tab added to my warning sign?

No. You may have a Share the Road, distance, **or** Crossing tab added to the basic diamond warning sign.

Is this program available for Forest Service Roads?

No. Forest Serve Roads, or Resource Roads, are not under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure.

Do I have to be a Horse Council BC member to apply for enhanced signage?

No. Any equestrian in BC may apply.
