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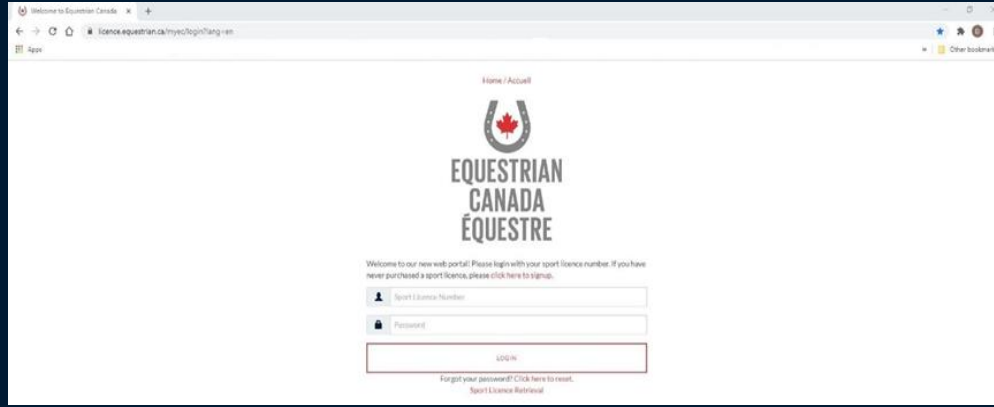

How do I apply for Coach Status?

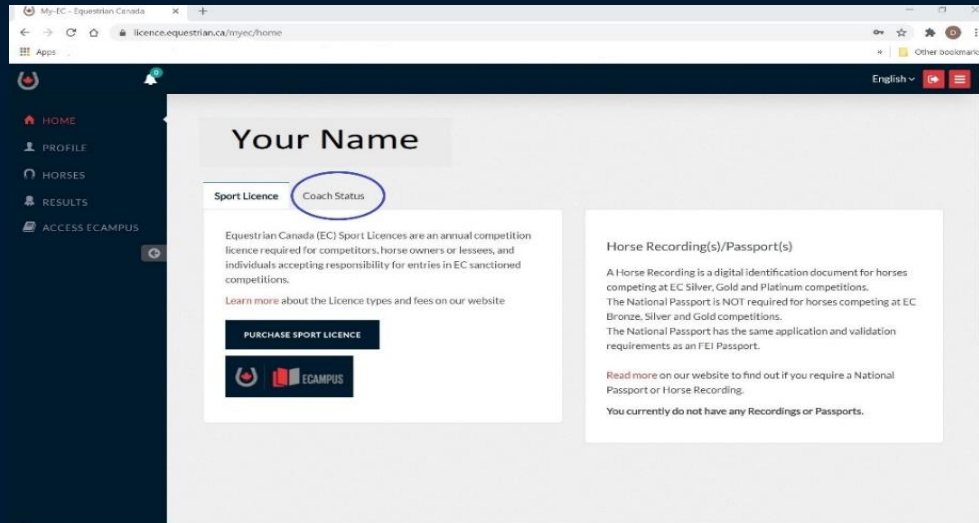


1. Login to [MyEC](#)

3. Complete Sport Licence Application, if not already completed

4. Confirm that you wish to purchase **Registered Coach** or **Licensed Coach Status**

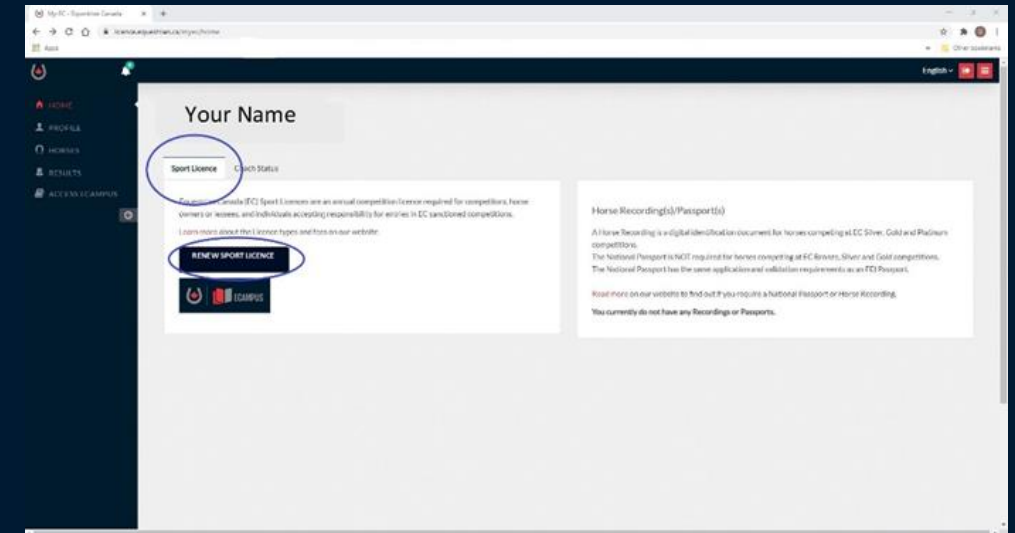

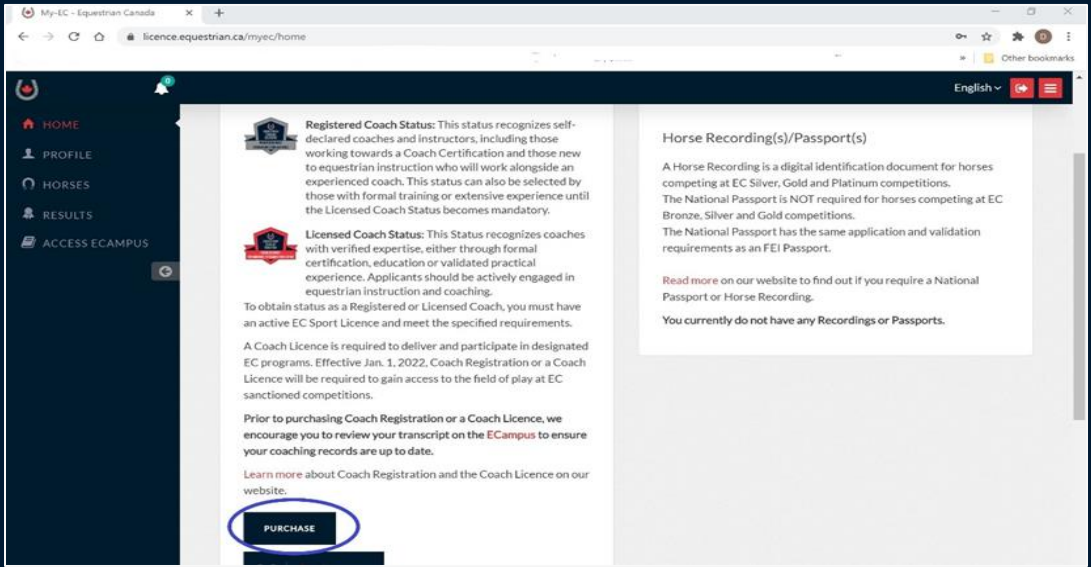

In applying for Equestrian Canada (EC) Coach Registration or a Coach Licence, I understand that my application is subject to review and approval by EC.

In order for my application to be accepted, I acknowledge that I:

- Agree to abide by all applicable bylaws, policies, rules and regulations of EC and my member Provincial/Territorial Sport Organization(s);
- Have read, fully understand and agree to abide by EC's Code of Conduct and Ethics;
- Am responsible for completing and maintaining all training, certification and registration requirements. Where training is not delivered through the ECampus, I will upload the appropriate documentation there; and,
- Will immediately notify EC of any changes in my status including but not limited to the expiry of insurance, certifications or membership.

Completion of Requirements (90 days)

Coach Registration and Coach Licence applicants have 90 days to complete all requirements. Failure to complete requirements within 90 days will result in the application being automatically declined and the applicant being required to re-submit to application process. Access to the e-learning module will be retained.

In the event of extraordinary circumstances, you may contact EC to request an extension by writing to coaching@equestrian.ca or calling 1-844-282-8295.

Processing Time

EC endeavours to process all Registered Coach and Coach Licence applications in a period of 3-5 business days after all documentation has been submitted. In peak periods, this process may take up to 10 business days. Should additional time be required, EC will notify all applicants accordingly.

Declined Applications

Should an application be declined, the applicant will be notified by email indicating that their application has been declined and the reason for the decision.

Refunds

Coach Registration fees are non-refundable upon purchase.

Coach Licence fees are non-refundable upon issuance. In the event of a declined application, Coach Licence fees will be refunded less a \$100 administration fee.

All individuals born prior to January 1, 1986 must request and submit a vulnerable sector check when completing an application to obtain an Equestrian Canada Coach Licence and/or when accepting a role identified as a level 3 risk in accordance with Equestrian Canada's screening policy. Individuals born after January 1, 1986 and those renewing their coach licence are only required to complete a vulnerable sector search if they submit a Criminal Record Check other than Sterling Backcheck's E-PIC.

What is a Vulnerable Sector Check (as per RCMP)
A vulnerable sector check is a police information check plus a check to see if a person has a record suspension (pardon) for sexual offences.

Vulnerable sector checks were created in 2000 to protect children and vulnerable persons and is governed by section 6.3(3) of the Criminal Records Act. Policies and procedures related to vulnerable sector checks can be found in the Dissemination of Criminal Record Information policy and the Ministerial Directive Concerning the Release of Criminal Record Information by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.

Questions concerning vulnerable sector checks should be directed to your local police service. In British Columbia, you should contact the British Columbia Criminal Records Review Program.

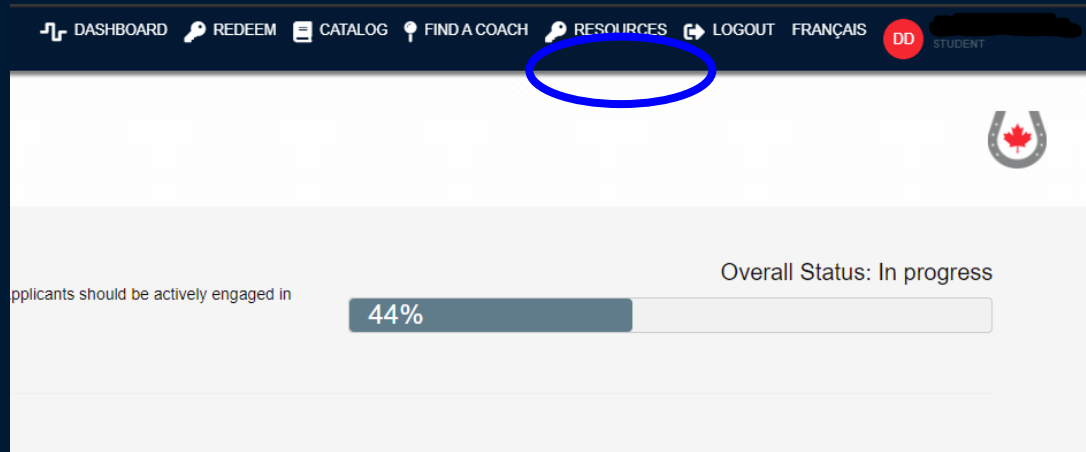

Training

- Coach status applicants must complete training in 3 designated areas.
 - First Aid
 - Concussion Awareness
 - Prevention of Maltreatment in Sport
- EC requires that training be completed at least once every 3 years, or sooner if based on the expiry date defined by the provider.



First Aid Training

- 100% online training is not recognized
- Certificate must be from a recognized Canadian provider
 - Canadian Red Cross; Saint-John Ambulance; Lifesaving Society; Ski Patrol and other organizations recognized by provincial workplace safety regulatory bodies
- The certificate must be valid at the time of application and must include completion and expiry date
- Most first aid certifications are valid for 2 or 3 years, as determined by the provider.
- International applicants may provide proof of equivalent qualification in their country of residence
- Qualifications from related professions e.g. paramedic will be recognized with documentation from professional licencing body and/or employer

COVID REQUIREMENT EXCEPTIONS – Until December 31, 2021

- Emergency First Aid will be accepted for Licenced Status
- Certificates which expired in 2020 or 2021 will be accepted, certificates which expired prior to 2020 will be accepted with an online refresher
- Previously completed ProFirst Aid
- Individuals who complete the online portion of blended program from a recognized provider

- Coverage of \$2 000 000 CGL & \$100 000 Professional Liability is required, EC and the home provincial federation must be named as additional insured
