The election/appointment of Officers to the Executive takes place at the HCBC Fall Board Meeting, November 5, 2022. The Nomination Committee's work will be to prepare a slate of candidates for the Board of Directors.

All individuals serving on the Nomination Committee must be current Horse Council BC adult/lifetime members in good standing as of the date of application closing; and **complete the Expression of Interest herein and return it to nomination@hcbc.ca by the deadline of March 17, 2022.** The Board of Directors will select the committee members at their Spring Meeting on March 26, 2022.

Nominations from the floor will not be permitted. Nomination Committee members may not run for a current Officer position or sit on the committee if an immediate family member is seeking office, nor may they nominate potential candidates.
