The horse demonstrates a clearer understanding of the aids. The correct geometry and lines of travel should be shown.	20-meter circles in jog and lope	Arena Size: Small (20m X 40m) or Large (20m X 60m) Average Ride Time: 4:00 (small) or 5:00 (large) MAXIMUM POINTS: 260
