

Rules

Horse Council BC rules will apply with 55+ BC Games exceptions.

- Each zone may send an unlimited number of participants.
- If entries are full or space is limited, one horse/rider combination will be given entry priority.
- Participants may enter two horses, but the horses must show in different disciplines or divisions.
- Participants may compete in a maximum of two disciplines (events)
- Horse/rider substitutions not permitted after the start of competition.

Navigators for Driving Trials

- May be under the age of 55 and are required to register as volunteers
- Navigators are required for all entries except VSE and Small Ponies in the Marathon phase and for any multiple turnout competitors.
- The same qualified Navigator may be used for multiple entries
- Callers for dressage and western dressage are allowed and are required to register as volunteers

- The Host Society Sport Chair will post schedules, draws and results at the venue throughout the competition
- Daily schedules may be changed dependent on number of entries
- Each participant will be assigned an entry number, which must be worn at all times during the competition. For participants entering more than one horse, the number will be assigned to each horse, not the participant.
- Tests, classes or patterns will be ridden each day.
- There will be no gate holds allowed if entering cross discipline.
- Results will be posted online at the end of each competition day
- All competitors must submit a completed Bio Security Form

Competition will take place September 9-12, 2026

- **Dressage - 2 days September 9-10**
- **Western Dressage - 2 days September 9-10**
- **Mountain Trail - 2 days September 9-10**
- **Driving Trials - 2 days September 11-12**
- **Ranch Horse - 2 days September 11-12**

Medals

All participants are encouraged to attend the medal presentations

Riders/drivers are encouraged to be appropriately dressed for presentations as there will be media in attendance and pictures taken

- a) Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the top three participants in each event (discipline) division each day
- b) Overall medals will be awarded for each division as an accumulation of points from each day of competition and will be awarded on the last day at the closing of competition.
- c) Medal presentations will take place at the end of the competition day at the venue
